
Back end priorities

- ◆ **Logging** - very **very** fast and detailed system to log everything
- ◆ **Reporting** - fast ways to retrieve, analyse and act on logged data
- ◆ **Caching** - implement fast caching all over Moodle
- ◆ **Notifications** - send messages and links direct to mobile devices
- ◆ **File plugins** - makes Moodle faster on clustered servers (cloud)



Front end priorities

- ◆ **Outcomes 2** - a deep integration of outcomes/competencies
- ◆ **Mobile access** - refining how Moodle works under Bootstrap
- ◆ **Mobile app** - support community effort with new HTML 5 app
- ◆ **Course management** - creating/deleting/archiving courses
- ◆ **Activities** - Assignment, Forum, Wiki, Survey
- ◆ **Analytics** - mini-reports throughout the interface and mobile

- ◆ **Efficiency** - streamlining workflow/policies and avoiding burnout
