#### How will the Association work?

- Non-profit organisation owned by Moodle users
- Collects annual fees for membership
- ◆ All fees go into a development fund
- Core development priorities are determined
- Fees are paid to Moodle HQ to develop these projects in core



## How are priorities determined?

Six-month cycles, matching Moodle releases

- 4 months specification period
  Any member can lead a project
  Project discussions online and working groups at Moots
- 1 month quoting and finalisation period
  Moodle HQ examines and cost estimates on each project
- 1 month voting period
  Level of membership determines voting points
  - Each member distributes votes among projects



# Final development

 The Association Committee allocates funds to the most highly voted projects

 Association contracts Moodle HQ to develop them for the earliest possible release
