How will the Association work?

- ◆ Non-profit organisation owned by Moodle users
- ◆ Collects annual fees for membership
- ◆ All fees go into a development fund
- ◆ Core development priorities are determined
- ◆ Fees are paid to Moodle HQ to develop these projects in core

How are priorities determined?

Six-month cycles, matching Moodle releases

- ◆ 4 months specification period
 - Any member can lead a project
 - Project discussions online and working groups at Moots
- ◆ 1 month quoting and finalisation period
 - Moodle HQ examines and cost estimates on each project
- ◆ 1 month voting period
 - Level of membership determines voting points
 - Each member distributes votes among projects

Final development

- ◆ The Association Committee allocates funds to the most highly voted projects
- ◆ Association contracts Moodle HQ to develop them for the earliest possible release

Membership

- ◆ Different tiers of memberships
- ◆ AU\$100/year to AU\$10,000 per year
- ◆ New committee elected each year
- ◆ We are looking for some key founding members to be on the initial committee
